- **4.** Accepted to an accredited institution (college or vocational).
- 5. Exhibited participation in community service and school activities.
- 6. Applications must be **emailed in PDF format** to the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee no later than *June 1, 2024*.

Any questions about the application should be directed to your college counselor. Winners will be notified by telephone. The winners and their parents will be invited to the Mount Prospect Lions Club Festival at Melas Park on the 4th of July for presentation of the scholarships.

A copy of your last report card (seven semesters) and the letters of recommendation can be scanned in for submission electronically. *All materials must be received by midnight, June 1, 2024.*
