

# 2024 Mount Prospect Lions Club Memorial Scholarship

The Lions willingly give time and talent to our club activities, to our community and professions promoting the objectives of the International Association of Lions Clubs. To serve our community, the Mount Prospect Lions Club will be awarding **\$15,000** in cash scholarships this year. The Mount Prospect Lions Club offers three different scholarships: The George Gattas Scholarship, in memory of a Past President of The Lions Club and former Educator at Prospect High School; The Tim Murphy Scholarship, former President of the Mount Prospect Lions Club and long-time Chairman of The Scholarship Committee; and the Mount Prospect Lions Scholarship, in honor of all deceased members of the Mount Prospect Lions Club.

With the assistance of area career and college counselors, we have established the following eligibility requirements for all applicants:

1. Must be a Mount Prospect resident.
2. Current graduating high school senior.
3. Evidence of academic achievement (i.e. National Honor Society, Honor Roll etc.).
4. Accepted to an accredited institution (college or vocational).
5. Exhibited participation in community service and school activities.
6. Applications must be **emailed in PDF format** to the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee no later than **June 1, 2024**.

Any questions about the application should be directed to your college counselor. Winners will be notified by telephone. The winners and their parents will be invited to the Mount Prospect Lions Club Festival at Melas Park on the 4th of July for presentation of the scholarships.

A copy of your last report card (seven semesters) and the letters of recommendation can be scanned in for submission electronically. **All materials must be received by midnight, June 1, 2024.**
